**A RESOLUTION OF THE  
MAMMOTH LAKES FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT**

**ADOPTING FINDINGS RELATING TO NUISANCE FIRE ALARMS**

WHEREAS, the Mammoth Lakes Fire Protection District responds to incidents within the indentified District boundary; and

WHEREAS, numerous structures within the Fire District are protected by properly installed, used, and maintained alarm systems. These alarm systems alert occupants and responders of true emergencies where corrective action is necessary to prevent the loss of life, property, and/or impacts on the environment, and

WHEREAS, some of these responses are nuisance and/or false alarms and are a result of malfunctions, misuse, and/or malicious behavior, resulting in wasted time and money. There is also the potential of an actual emergency response being slowed as a result of responding to a false alarm. Preventive measures are therefore needed to ensure the preservation of the public peace, health, or safety,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Fire Commissioners of the Mammoth Lakes Fire Protection District hereby finds that local conditions necessitate the adoption of a fee structure that addresses frequent nuisance and/or false alarm responses.
